Doylestown is alive with the hustle and bustle that marks a place where everyone wants to be. Whether you work here or are stopping by to shop, dine, attend the County Theater, visit the museums, or just hang out, parking nearby will be on your list of things to do. This guide can help you locate the parking areas that put you close to your destination, while alerting you to the hourly limit. Since feeding the meter is strictly prohibited, *Park Smart* by choosing a 10-hour metered space for visits longer than three hours on Monday through Saturday from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. By selecting a parking spot appropriate to your length of stay, everyone will benefit.

### ***Park Smart to avoid fines:***

**\$10.00-** expired meter

**\$50.00-** feeding meter after initial period

### **Bucks County Parking Garage**

Near the Courthouse on Broad Street and a less than 5 minute short walk to downtown. Free Parking – 24 hours per day. Entrance on Broad Street. Additional entrances on Union and Doyle Streets.

## **Park Smart**

*at free 15 minute spaces*

For short errands or “grab and go” convenience. Corner locations on State St., Main St., the Dommel Way Parking Lot, and Plaza East parking lot on Oakland Avenue.

## **Park Smart**

*at 3 hour meters*

For appointments, shopping, dining, and the movies \$.25/hr.—accepts nickels, dimes, and quarters Located: Central to the downtown, on-street and in the following **Municipal Lots:** Court St. / Pine & State Streets / Oakland Avenue & Donaldson Street. Also in the Hamilton & State Street Municipal Lot one block from State and Main St., the heart of the downtown. Metered by machine, Pay and display the ticket on your dash.

## **Park Smart**

*At designated 10 hour yellow banded meters*

For employees, employers, and visitors who are here for the day. Results in more parking downtown for customers and clients. 281 available spaces:

### **BY PERMIT**

- ◆ Purchase a \$50 six-month permit at Borough Hall (equivalent to parking at a cost of \$.27/ day)
- ◆ Display it on your driver’s side dashboard. No coins needed for the meter. Permit is transferable to another car.

-or-

### **BY METER**

- ◆ \$.25 for each two hours of meter time—accepts quarters only

## **TRAIN & BUS**

Pay and Park at Train Station Septa Lot. For overnight, use free spaces on S. Clinton or Bridge Streets.

# CITIZEN'S GUIDE TO PUBLIC PARKING

## Borough of Doylestown Public Parking Lots

1. Plaza West, Hamilton & State Streets, "Pay & Display" system.
2. Dommel Way, Between Court & State Streets, 15 min. & 3 hr. parking.
3. Pine Street, Pine & State Streets, 3 hr. meters.
4. Plaza East, E. Oakland Avenue and Donaldson Street, 3 hr. meters.
5. Clinton Street, Clinton & W. Court Streets; monthly rentals, 10 hr. meters, Free Evening/Weekend Parking.
6. Wood Street, Wood Street between Hamilton and Clinton; monthly rentals.
7. Bucks County Parking Garage, Broad and Union Streets, 24 hour free parking.
8. Wells Fargo Bank Lot, free weekday parking from 6:00pm to 2:00AM, noon Saturday to 2:00am Monday morning.
9. County "VIP" Lot, free parking 6:00pm to 3:00am weekdays and all day Saturday & Sundays.
